Verb-masen ka/verb-masho (let's) - asking the person where you would like to meet and when - Acceptance and refusal of invitations Watashi wa kuruma ga arimasu I have a car Tokyo de Olympic ga arimasu There will be Olympic in Tokyo Verbs -te form and -nai form 'Kabuki o mite shokuji o shimasu': I watch Kabuki, and then have a meal
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
